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RAVI SHANKER JHA, C.J. (ORAL)

In reference to the order dated 30.3.2019, passed by a Coordinate Bench, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the only prayer that survives in the petition, as of now, is to direct the respondent-States to enact a law in respect of the issues raised in the petition.

As to this, learned counsel appearing for the States of Punjab and Haryana, submit that if the petitioner submits a representation to the respective State Governments as regards his concerns and grievances, the same shall be duly considered and dealt with, in accordance with law.

In response, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that let this petition be disposed of, in the wake of the statement made by the learned State counsel, as the petitioner shall submit a comprehensive representation to both the State Governments, at the earliest.

That being so, the petition is accordingly disposed of, in terms of the statements made by learned counsel for the parties.

We are sanguine that in the event any such representation, as indicated above, is submitted, the same shall be duly examined and appropriate measures/decision in this regard shall be taken.
