The petitioners seeks the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in a case bearing FIR No.202 dated 23.09.2021, under Sections 323, 341, 506, 148, 149, IPC and (Sections 325 and 308 IPC added later on) registered with Police Station Dirba, Distt. Sangrur.

The learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in compliance of the order dated 29.04.2022, petitioners have joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

The learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Mahipal submits that though the petitioners have joined the investigation in terms of the order dated 29.04.2022, but he is required for custodial interrogation. On a query, he is unable to justify as to why the petitioners are required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, interim order dated 29.04.2022 is made absolute. However, the petitioners shall keep on joining the

investigation as and when required to do so and they shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of.
