Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of interim regular bail for 20 days in case FIR No.25 dated 17.02.2022, under Sections 18, 25 and 29 NDPS Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Sadar Jagraon, District Ludhiana, to enable him to attend the marriage of his son, namely, Amarjit Singh Toor, which is scheduled for 08.05.2022.

Learned counsel for petitioner contends that the marriage of petitioner's son is to be solemnized on 08.05.2022 and has invited the attention of the Court to the marriage card (Annexure P-3). He prays that the petitioner be released on interim bail for a period of twenty days.

Notice of the application to respondent-State.

At this stage, Mr. Dhruv Dayal, Sr. DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and states that indeed the marriage of the petitioner is scheduled for 08.05.2022.

After considering the prayer made by learned counsel for the

petitioner and the stand of learned State counsel, this Court is not inclined to grant interim regular bail to the petitioner, however, it is directed that the Superintendent Central Jail, Ludhiana, after verification shall facilitate the visit of petitioner to the venue to attend his son's marriage ceremony and after completion of ceremony, he be brought back to the prison. It is made clear that all the expenses for travel, etc. shall be borne by petitioner.
