This order shall dispose of CR-1057-2021 and
CR-2338-2021.

The dispute is with regard to the correctness of the order
passed by the trial Court impounding two different agreements to sell
produced in two different suits, between the same parties. The Court has
directed the plaintiff to fix stamp duty on the total sale consideration
along with the penalty of 10 times of the amount payable.

After arguing for some time, the learned counsel representing the parties have come to a consensus, they jointly pray that let the impugned orders be set aside with a direction to the trial Court to pass fresh orders in accordance with law while keeping all the issues open.

Ordered accordingly.

With these observations, both the petitions are disposed of.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
