Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. praying for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.1&2 to entrust the investigation in case FIR No.33, dated 14.03.2022 (Annexure P-1), under Sections 354/354A IPC, registered at Police Station Women, Ambala, to some independent agency.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that FIR in this case got registered on 14.03.2022, however, no progress in the investigation has been made.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr.B.S.Virk, DAG, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents and submits that investigation in this case is going on and the accused are yet to be arrested. He submits that investigation would be completed in accordance with law.

Heard.

In view of the prayer made in the petition, the same is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2, i.e. Superintendent of Police, Ambala City, to ensure that the investigation be carried out by the competent officer as having the jurisdiction in accordance with law and as per the provisions of the Code of Criminal Procedure and the same be completed as expeditiously as possible preferably within one month from today.
