Complaining violation of directions issued by the Court in CWP-1353-2022, titled as “Pardeep Vs. State of Haryana and others”, dated 08.02.2022, the petitioner has filed the present petition under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971. The operative part of the order reads as under:-

“Having regard to the said submission, this Writ Petition is disposed of by directing the petitioner to submit representation of the nature contained in Annexure P1 to respondent No.2, and within 4 weeks of receipt of the said representation, respondent No.2 shall dispose it of in accordance with law, and communicate his decision to the petitioner.”

Learned counsel for the respondent submits that the Director, Mines and Geology Department is out of country and the moment he comes back, the matter will be decided. He undertakes that the matter shall be decided by 15.05.2022.

Keeping in view the aforesaid, no further orders are required to be passed.
