[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1, dated 15.07.2022 in CWP No.9851 of 2020.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that while issuing notice of motion in CWP No.9851 of 2020 for 27.10.2020 it was ordered on 15.07.2020 that in the meantime, operation of the impugned orders dated 12.06.2020 and 07.11.2017 were stayed.

[3] Learned AAG has produced reply dated 22.09.2022 along with Annexure R/1 dated 27.05.2022. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioners who on perusal of Annexure R/1 dated 27.05.2022 states that in view of needful having been done and the petitioners being paid salary as per their entitlement, he does not press the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

[4] In view of the position noted above as well as the statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the instant petition is disposed of as not

calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
