This petition is filed for grant of anticipatory bail in case of FIR No.4 dated 5.4.2022, under Section 7 of Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988, registered at Police Station Vigilance Bureau, Ludhiana.

Vide order dated 26th May, 2022, the petitioner was granted interim anticipatory bail subject to joining investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Gulsher Singh submits that the petitioner has joined investigation, he is required to join investigation again and to give his voice sample.

Learned counsel for complainant vehemently opposes the prayer for confirmation of interim bail.

In view of statement made by learned State counsel, the interim anticipatory bail granted is made absolute, subject to petitioner joining the investigation as and when called for and on his giving the voice sample.

Disposed of accordingly.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending application, if any is rendered infructuous.
