Complaining violation of directions issued by the High Court in Civil Writ Petition No.22282 of 2021, titled as “Dr. Parmender Singh Brar and others Vs. State of Punjab and another” dated 15.12.2021, the petitioners have filed the present petition under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.

The operative part of the order dated 15.12.2021, reads as under:-

“Upon hearing learned counsel of both the sides and on perusal of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with the directions to the official respondents to consider the representations Annexure P-13 to P-15 and decide the same, moved by the petitioners, in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

If found entitled and if there is no impediment for the relief, the same be granted to the petitioner without any delay, as per law.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.”

Before initiating contempt proceedings, one more opportunity is granted to the respondents to comply with the order with a period of one month, from today.

Let a copy of the order be sent by the petitioners to the respondents, by the registered post acknowledgment due within a period of 10 days.

It is hoped that the respondents will comply with the order, failing which the petitioners shall have liberty to file an application for revival, if the order is not complied with.

With all these observations, the present petition is disposed of.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
