AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

This petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is filed seeking regular bail in FIR No. 50, dated 9th May, 2019, under Sections 302, 392 of IPC, 1860 and Sections 25/27 of Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Nehianwala, District Bathinda.

During the pendency of the petition, on 15th July, 2021 directions were issued to trial Court to make an earnest effort to examine the prosecution witnesses and conclude the trial at the earliest.

In spite of two pass overs, none has put an appearance on behalf of the petitioner.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Parwinder Singh states that on 9th February, 2022 petitioner was acquitted in the present FIR by the Additional Sessions Judge, Bathinda.

In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, this petition is disposed of as infructuous.

In case of discrepancy in the statement made by learned State counsel, petitioner would be at liberty to file an application for recalling of the order.
