The prayer under Section 438 Cr.PC is for grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.132 dated 25.03.2022 under Sections 148, 149, 186, 332, 353, 427 and 506 IPC at Police Station Sector 14, Panchkula.

Learned Counsel for the petitioners submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 28.04.2022 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of orders dated 28.04.2022 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 28.04.2022 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation

as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
