This is second petition seeking regular bail in case of FIR No. 56 dated 16.4.2021, under Section 22 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (for short 'the Act'), registered at Police Station Dharamkot, District Moga.

Learned State counsel opposes the petition and submits that the petitioner has not approached this Court with clean hands. In Para-10 of petition it is pleaded that the petitioner is first offender whereas (as per custody certificate) he is involved in another case i.e. FIR No. 95 dated 19.5.2020 under Section 21/29 of the Act, registered at Dharamkot..

Learned counsel for the petitioner realizing that a wrong information was given to him by the client, seeks permission to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
