This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No. 117 dated 26.06.2020 under Sections 452, 307, 506, 294, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Focal Point, District Police Commissionerate Ludhiana (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising on the basis of the compromise.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that there are three more victims but however the said victims have not been made party nor the compromise has been effected between them and thus, he withes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file a fresh petition after making all the necessary persons as party.
