Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.0124 dated 05.11.2020 registered under Sections 406, 420, 506 IPC and Section 10/24 of Immigration Act, 1924 Police Station City Pehowa, District Kurukshetra.

The counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* submits that the petitioner was falsely implicated in the present case at the instance of complainant and the only allegation against the petitioner is that out of the disputed amount, an amount of Rs.2.5 lakhs was deposited in his bank account and immediately thereafter the said amount was transferred in the bank account of wife of co-accused Rajesh. The said lady was not arrayed as an accused in the present case and her husband Rajesh has been given benefit of anticipatory bail by the coordinate Bench of this Court vide order

dated 23.03.2021 having CRM-M-40966-2020. The counsel for the petitioner further submitted that in pursuance to the previous order of this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police.

The State counsel on instructions from SI Balbir Singh admitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police and further not refuted the fact that immediately after deposit of amount of Rs.2.5 lakhs in the bank account of the petitioner, the same was transferred in the bank of account of wife of co-accused Rajesh but she is not implicated as an accused in the present case and her husband Rajesh has been given benefit of anticipatory bail.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 10.05.2021 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
