Complaining wilful disobedience of the order dated 10.02.2022 passed in CWP-2449-2022, the petitioner has filed the present contempt petition. The operative part of the order dated 10.02.2022 reads as under:-

“Upon hearing learned counsel of both the sides and one of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with the directions to the official respondents to consider the representations dated 25.03.2021 (Annexure P-4) and dated 27.10.2021 (Annexure P5) moved by the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law , by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

If found entitled and if there is no impediment for the relief, the same be granted to the petitioner without any delay, as per law.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly .”

Learned State counsel has stated that the payment payable to the petitioner has been calculated while granting him benefit of Assured Career Progression Scheme. However, a detailed order, as directed, will be passed within a period of one month, from today.

In view of the aforesaid facts, no further order is required to be passed. The petitioner shall be at liberty to file an application for revival, if the order is not passed within the stipulated period.
