[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 10.02.2021 in CWP No.2987 of 2021 in case titled as Giriraj and Ors. Vs. State of Haryana and Ors..

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP No.2987 of 2021 was disposed of by directing the respondent to decide the claim of the petitioners by passing a speaking order in terms of decision of this Court dated 05.11.2014 in CWP No.14621 of 2014 in case titled as M/s Dharam Pal Contractors Hot Mix Plants Danewala and Others vs. State of Punjab within four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and in case the petitioners were found entitled, to release payment to them within next six weeks.

[3] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners states that needful having been done in terms of order, Annexure P/1 dated 10.02.2021, the petitioners are not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

[4] In the light of position noted above as well as the statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the contempt petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.

[5] Rule discharged.

[6] All pending misc. applications also stand disposed of.
