Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the members of the petitioner-Federation are the retirees to the Government Aided Colleges of Haryana, who retired prior to 11.05.1998, i.e. prior to the date when the pension scheme was made available to the employees of the aided institutions. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the case of the members of the petitioner-Federation is covered by the judgment passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court in **2018(2) SCT (P&H) 507 “Kidar Nath Kohli and others Vs. State of Haryana and others”**.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the same grievance has also been raised on behalf of the members of the petitioner-Federation before the respondents by serving representation dated 19.01.2022 (Annexure P-7), which is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned and the members of the petitioner-Federation will be satisfied at this stage, in case a time bound direction is given to respondent

No.1 to decide the said representation dated 19.01.2022, by passing an

appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Narender Singh Behgal, AAG, Haryana, keeping in view the advance service of the copy of petition, accepts notice on behalf of the State and raises no objection, in case prayer made hereinbefore on behalf of the petitioner-Federation for deciding the representation dated 19.01.2022 (Annexure P-7) in a time bound manner is accepted.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of this case and without going into merits of the claim as raised on behalf of the petitioner-Federation in the present case as well as in the representation dated 19.01.2022 (Annexure P-7), this petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.1 to pass an appropriate speaking order on the representation dated 19.01.2022 (Annexure P-7), filed on behalf of the members of the petitioner-Federation, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of the copy of this order.
