This is a petition that has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No.2 to consider the case of the petitioner for physical measurement test, which was not attended by him due to medical emergency, for the post of Sub-Inspector (Male) advertised vide Advertisement No.3/2021.

At the very outset, counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner restricts his prayer for deciding the representation dated 28.10.2021 (Annexure P-5) of the petitioner whereby he has requested to consider his case for physical measurement test for the post of Sub Inspector (Male), which test he could not attend as he was admitted in hospital. He would submit that the petitioner would be satisfied in case the said representation is decided in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

At this stage, Mr. Tapan Kumar, DAG, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and would submit that the respondents will look into the matter and will take a decision on the representation of the petitioner.

Let sufficient number of copies of the complete paper book be supplied to him during the course of day.

Without adverting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of by directing the respondents to take a decision on the representation dated 28.10.2021 (Annexure P-5) of the petitioner, within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law, and convey the decision to the petitioner. In case of failure to do so, the officer responsible for the lapse would be liable to costs of Rs.20,000/- from his personal pocket, to be deposited with the Punjab and Haryana High Court Advocates Welfare Fund.
