Petitioner has prayed for grant of interim regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C, pending trial in case FIR No.0236 dated 05.07.2020 registered under Sections 18 and 27(a) NDPS Act, 1985 (Sections 61 and 85 NDPS Act added later on) at Police Station Sadar Fatehabad, District Fatehabad to enable him to manage the surgery/operation of his wife Sashi Bala.

Learned counsel has argued that the wife of the petitioner, namely, Sashi Bala is suffering from the problem of gallbladder sludge (i.e. Stone in gallbladder) and also the problem of Mild Splenomegaly. As per the advice of the doctor, she has to undergo surgery/operation for removal of the stone from her gallbladder and also to treat the problem of mild splenomegaly. In this regard, he has invited the attention of the Court to the medical record of petitioner's wife (Annexure P-2). He prays for release of the petitioner on interim regular bail, as his presence is necessary at the time of operation and for follow up treatment.

During the course of hearing, it is not disputed that petitioner's

wife was treated/diagnosed by the doctor on 29.09.2021 and thereafter, she never visited the doctor for treatment nor any date of surgery has been fixed. Even, his wife is being attended by his children, who are 20 years and 17 years respectively and can take care of their mother in the absence of petitioner.

Considering the above background, no case is made out for grant of interim regular bail to the petitioner.

Dismissed.
