[1] Prayer in the instant petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 27.09.2021 in CWP No.19534 of 2021 in case titled as Ram Diya vs. State of Haryana and another.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP No.19534 of 2021 was disposed of by directing respondent No.2 therein to decide representation dated 03.11.2020 filed by the petitioner and take a conscious decision thereon by passing a speaking order within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and in case it was found that the petitioner was entitled to any pecuniary benefits, to release the benefits to the petitioner with three months thereafter.

[3] Learned DAG has produced copy of speaking order dated 20.05.2022 in Court. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal of the same states that in view the claim of the petitioner as contained in representation dated

03.11.2020 having been rejected, the petitioner may be permitted to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to challenge speaking order, dated 20.05.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

[4] In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
