[1] Prayer in the petition under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 is for initiating action against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of orders, Annexure P/1 dated 16.02.2021 in CWP No.2182 of 2021 in case titled as Vinod Kumar and another vs. State of Haryana and Ors.

[2] None is present on behalf of the petitioners. For that matter, none was present on behalf of the petitioners on 27.08.2021.

[3] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 dated 16.02.2021 reveals that CWP No.2182 of 2021 was disposed of by granting liberty to the petitioners to submit representation to the respondents and the respondents were directed to decide the same by passing a speaking order within six weeks from the date of receipt of representation.

[4] Learned DAG states that speaking order, Annexure R/1 dated 25.08.2021 was passed by respondent No.1 rejecting the claim of the petitioners as made in the representation filed by the petitioners.

Learned DAG states that the aforementioned reply along with Annexure R/1 attached thereto has already been supplied to

learned counsel for the petitioners.

[5] As noticed above, none is present on behalf of the petitioners but in the light of the position noted above, the contempt petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against respondent No.1 under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioners to challenge order, Annexure R/1 dated 25.08.2021 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law. Liberty is also granted to the petitioners to move an application for revival of the contempt petition in case, cause survives.
