This is a petition that has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.70 dated 07.05.2011, under Sections 420, 406, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Raikot, District Ludhiana as well as subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

Counsel for the petitioners herein would contend that the matter stands settled between the parties, as would be evident from the statements recorded before the Lok Adalat.

At this stage, status report filed by the respondent-State by way of affidavit of Mr. Rajinder Singh, PPS, DSP, Raikot, District Ludhiana

(Rural) is taken on record. As per the status report filed, the matter stands investigated and a cancellation report has already been filed on 28.02.2022. Based on the said cancellation report, counsel for the respondent-State submits that the matter stands rendered infructuous.

On the other hand, counsel for respondent No.2 would submit that as per his instructions, there is no compromise.

At this stage, counsel for the petitioner does not press the instant petition in view of the reply filed, however, seeks liberty to take appropriate recourse, in accordance with law, in case, the cancellation report is not accepted.

Dismissed as not pressed, with the aforesaid liberty.
