The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for issuance of a direction to the learned JMIC, Ludhiana to fast track the Kalandra under Section 66 of the Police Station bearing No.CHA/691/2015 titled as 'State Vs. Manji Kaur' and decide the same expeditiously.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in the present case, the Kalandra is of the year 2014 and has submitted that the pendency of the case is causing prejudice to the rights of the present petitioner. It is further submitted that although the case is listed for the defence witness, but the petitioner does not want to examine any other defence witness, other than the witnesses, who have already been examined.

Keeping in view the above-said facts and circumstances, more so, the fact that the Kalandra is of the year 2014 and the proceedings are pending since more than 7 ½ years, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Ludhiana to decide the same as expeditiously as possible.

Learned counsel for the accused as well as other persons are directed to assist the Court in expeditious disposal of the said case.
