Learned counsel for the respondents-State submits that as per the instructions received from the Department, all the benefits for which the petitioner is entitled for, have already been released to him.

Learned counsel for the respondents further submits that the gratuity as well as commutation of pension has been withheld due to the pendency of the disciplinary proceedings against the petitioner and the said act is within the parameters of the law.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that let the respondents conclude the disciplinary proceedings in a time bound manner so that the petitioner does not suffer any further prejudice.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the disciplinary proceedings, which are pending against the petitioner, will be completed within a period of six months from the receipt of copy of this

order and thereafter, withheld benefits will be released to the petitioner in accordance with law.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned counsel for the respondents, no further grievance of the petitioner survives in the present petition and the same may kindly be disposed of as such.
