[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 05.04.2021, in CWP No.19242 of 2020 in case titled as '**Mukesh Kumar** versus **National Institute of Technology, Kurukshetra and another**'.

[2] A perusal of paragraph No.13 of Annexure P-1 reveals that CWP No.19242 of 2020 was allowed, impugned order dated 12.10.2020 quashed and respondent No.1 directed to issue NOC in favour of the petitioner.

[3] Learned counsel for respondent No.2 has produced copy of NOC issued by the National Institute of Technology, Kurukshetra, subject to decision of LPA No.454 of 2021 as well as subject to eligibility and terms and conditions of the Ph.D. Ordinance of the Kurukshetra University,

Kurukshetra. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof, states that in view of issuance of NOC dated 16.09.2022, the petitioner does not wish to pursue the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

[4] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
