The petitioner herein has sought the relief of pre-arrest bail in the criminal case arising out of the FIR bearing No.49 dated 17.12.2021 registered at Police Station NRI, Ludhiana, under Sections 196, 200, 420, 468 and 120-B IPC, wherein the offences under Sections 467 and 471 IPC are stated to have been added later-on.

Today, on the instructions from SI Ravinder Singh from the above-said Police Station, learned State counsel apprises the Court that in compliance of the order dated 18.05.2022 as passed by the Co-ordinate Bench, the petitioner has joined in the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required and he is also not involved in any other

criminal case of the similar nature.

In view of the above-discussed submission as made by learned State counsel, the instant petition is allowed and the relief of interim bail, as extended to the petitioner by the Co-ordinate Bench vide the said order dated 18.05.2022, is hereby made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall continue to join in the investigation as and when required/called upon to do so and shall also strictly abide by all the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
