This is a first petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR no.18 dated 03.03.2021 registered under Sections 22 and 29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances, Act, 1985 at Police Station Daba, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that although in the present case, the recovery of heroin is 12 grams which is non commercial quantity but the petitioner does not press the present petition at this stage as the petitioner is on interim bail in view of the directions issued by the High Powered Committee and submitted that petitioner be granted liberty to file a fresh petition for regular bail after the said period of interim bail lapses and the petitioner surrenders.

In view of the statement given by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn, at this stage, with liberty aforesaid.
