Through the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. the petitioner seeks issuance of directions to the State to register an FIR against respondents No.3 to 13 for having committed offences under Sections 307, 325, 323, 336, 338, 341, 436, 327, 354-A, 354-B, 379-B, 506, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25, 27, 54 and 59 of the Arms Act, 1959.

At the outset, learned State counsel, on the strength of the affidavit filed on behalf of the State, submits that the petitioner and respondents No.3 to 13 have compromised the matter and in this regard have got their statements recorded before the Police.
