KARAMJIT SINGH, J.

The petitioner has approached this Court seeking grant of regular bail in a case having FIR No.67 dated 7.12.2021 registered under Sections 419 and 420 IPC at Police Station Cyber Crime, District Faridabad.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that initially the petitioner was not named in the FIR, but later on nominated and is in custody since 27.01.2022. The counsel further contends that the after investigation, challan has been presented and co-accused Tarun Singh has already been granted regular bail by this Court vide order 23.05.2022 passed in CRM-M-21498 of 2022.

Learned State counsel has not controverted the fact regarding custody period of the petitioner as well as the fact that he was not named in the FIR and the fact that challan has been presented on completion of investigation and grant of regular bail to the co-accused.

I have considered the submissions made by counsel for the parties.

It will take considerable time for the trial to conclude. Thus, no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind the bars for an indefinite period. Thus without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/CJM/Duty Magistrate concerned.
