The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.305 dated 07.09.2020, registered under Sections 61/63 of the Punjab Excise Act and Section 420 IPC at Police Station Jandiala, District Amritsar (Rural).

The operative part of the order dated 05.07.2021, vide which interim anticipatory bail has been granted to the petitioner, is reproduced as under:-

“....Submits inter alia that the petitioner was originally granted interim anticipatory bail but he could not join the investigation on account of his illness, in support of which he has annexed the Medical Certificate, Annexure P-3.

Notice of motion.... ”

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that, in pursuance to the order dated 05.07.2021, the petitioner has appeared before the Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Gurmeet Singh, has not disputed the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 05.07.2021 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
