Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to conduct fair and proper investigation in FIR No.88 dated 03.07.2019, registered under Sections 323, 324, 325, 506 and 34 IPC and Sections 3/4 of the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 (added later on), at Police Station Kathu Nangal, District Amritsar Rural and after completion of the investigation, the challan may be presented against the accused before the competent Court of jurisdiction.

Learned State counsel has pointed out that in the present case, the report under Section 173 Cr.P.C./challan has been presented on

30.04.2020 and thus, the present has been rendered infructuous.
