This is in fact third petition that has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C., for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.22 dated 30.01.2020 under Sections 21 and 29 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Special Task Force, STF Wing, SAS Nagar, Mohali.

It has been noticed that the first bail petition of the petitioner was dismissed on merits vide order dated 24.02.2021 passed by this Court. Subsequent thereto, another bail application for regular bail was filed which stood dismissed as withdrawn vide order dated 29.06.2021.

It is well settled that successive applications for grant of regular bail are not entertained unless there is a drastic change in the circumstances. Keeping in view the fact that though the petitioner has been indicted in the present case on the basis of disclosure statement but there

has been a recovery of heroin and money from him, I find no ground for grant of regular bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed.

At this stage, counsel for the petitioner requests that trial Court be directed to conclude the trial expeditiously.

Ordered accordingly.
