The present application has been filed by the applicant-petitioner No. 3 under Order 47 Rule 1 of the Code of Civil Procedure for reviewing of order dated 06.01.2020 passed by this Court.

Learned counsel for the applicant-petitioner No. 3 states that the respondent-department has made appointments (R-2 and R-3) in other trades also in the same manner. In Electronics/Mechanical Instructor and in Fitter trade also, ITI/CTI candidates have been appointed against vacant post of degree holders in the year 2019, as well as 2017.

Learned State counsel states that these annexure (R-2 and R-3) were not part of the writ petition, which was decided on 06.01.2020. The grievance of the petitioners was to be considered only with respect to advertisement dated 24.04.2016, which was for 1025 posts of various trades on contractual basis in the Industrial Training Haryana. Learned State counsel states that Annexure R-2 deals with the selection process after 24.04.2016. Learned State counsel states that in the RTI reply dated 03.06.2020 (R-4), it has been clearly mentioned that the candidates had been selected due to non-availability of eligible degree/diploma candidates. Similarly, in dress making trade 2 degree/diploma candidates were appointed, due to non-availability of eligible degree/diploma candidates.

In view of the above factual position, no ground is made out for review of order dated 06.01.2020 passed by this Court.

The application is dismissed.
