Complaining non-compliance of the order dated 08.03.2022,
the petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 12 of the
Contempt of Courts Act, 1971. The operative part of the order reads as
under:-

“This petition has been filed by the petitioner by way of public interest alleging that the respondent - authorities are not taking action and infact permitting overloading over the vehicles transporting minerals and thereby causing damage to the roads as well as violating the provisions of Section 113 of the Motor Vehicles Act , 1988. It is submitted that the petitioner's representation dated 11.02.2022 (Annexure P - 3) filed in this regard has not yielded any result till date . Hence this petition .

Learned Additional Advocate General appearing for the respondent - State of Haryana , on advance copy , submits that the aforesaid representation filed by the petitioner shall be considered and a decision thereon shall be taken expeditiously in accordance with law.

In view of the aforesaid statement made by learned Additional Advocate General , Haryana , the petition stands disposed of with a direction to the respondent - authorities to decide the petitioner's representation dated 11.02.2022 (Annexure P-3) expeditiously in accordance with law and if so required to take necessary action to ensure due compliance of the law and prevent overloading.”

Learned counsel representing the respondent submits that the meeting of the concerned officers has been held and a decision on the representation will be taken positively within a period of 15 days, from today.

In view of the aforesaid, no further order is required to be passed.

Disposed of.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
