Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking quashing of order dated 06.02.2016 passed by JMIC, Jalandhar, Annexure P-1, by which the petitioner was declared as proclaimed offender in Complaint No.388 of 2018 registered for offences under Sections 406, 498-A, 504 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise deed dated 29.09.2020, Annexure P-2.

At the outset, counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in Italy and due to the unprecedented situation arising due to the outbreak of the pandemic, he is unable to come to India, surrender before the Court concerned and join the proceedings. She seeks permission to withdraw the petition with liberty to file a fresh one, after the petitioner returns to India.
