This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of the order dated 23.01.2001 passed in Case No.RBT/76/2000/98 of 1998 instituted on dated 04.04.1998 titled as '**State Versus Harmesh Singh**', in FIR No.416 dated 08.08.1998 under Sections 279, 337 & 338 of IPC registered at Police Station Shahbad, District Kurukshetra, whereby the Learned JMIC, Kurukshetra declared the present petitioner a proclaimed offender and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom as the matter has been compromised between the petitioner and the complainant on the basis of affidavit of complainant dated 22.03.2022.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that due to inadvertence, State of Punjab has been impleaded as Party-respondent to the petition instead of State of Haryana. He further requests that the said error be rectified and respondent be read as State of Haryana.

On his oral request, State of Haryana is being impleaded as party-respondent to the present petition and respondent be read as State of Haryana in place of State of Punjab. Office is directed to do the needful.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner had deposited the amount of Rs.50,000/- as costs with the PGI Poor Patients' Welfare Fund in terms of order dated 02.05.2022 passed by this Court. In this regard, order dated 10.05.2022 passed by the trial Court has been placed on record, in which observation regarding depositing of amount has been made.

Since, the petitioner had deposited the amount in compliance of order dated 02.05.2022 and has surrendered before the trial Court, no further orders are required to be passed in this petition.

Disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
