Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the petitioner was wrongly retired from service on 30.06.2019 whereas, keeping in view the date of birth recorded in the service record of the petitioner, he should have been retired on 31.10.2019, which fact has already been brought to the notice of the respondent-department by the petitioner but, even after retirement, no benefits have been given to the petitioner so far.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance before the respondents by way of serving a legal notice dated 26.03.2021 (Annexure P/6), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondent No.2 to decide the said legal notice.

Mr. Raman Kumnar Sharma, Addl. A.G. Haryana, who is

present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and raises no objection in deciding the legal notice dated 26.03.2021 (Annexure P/6) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the request made, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner in his legal notice, respondent No.2 is directed to decide the legal notice dated 26.03.2021 (Annexure P/6) by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
