Petitioner seeks security/police protection for himself and his family members as he apprehends threat thereto having given a statement against the accused in FIR No.2 dated 20.12.2021, registered under Sections 25, 27-A, 29 of NDPS Act at Police Station State Crime, SAS Nagar.

Reply-cum-status report dated 11.07.2022, by way of affidavit of Varinder Singh Khosa, PPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, North, Amritsar City, with a copy thereof to learned counsel for the petitioner, has been filed in Court today. Same is taken on record, subject to just exceptions. Learned counsel for the State while referring to the said affidavit submits that after assessment of threat perception and on receipt of factual report, adequate security has been provided to the petitioner. Four security personnel were provided vide order dated 14.05.2022 and four additional security personnel have been provided to the petitioner vide order dated 18.06.2022, passed by the ADGP Security, Punjab. In this view of the matter, this writ petition, it is submitted, is rendered infructuous.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is unable to deny the same.

In view of the facts and circumstances as above, this petition is disposed of as infructuous without any expression of opinion on the merits of the matter.
