Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.548 dated 08.09.2021 under Sections 354, 376 (2) (a) (i), 511 of IPC, 1860, and Section 03 of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989, registered at Police Station City Sonapat, District Sonapat, Annexure P-1, alongwith all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise.

Mr. Ashwani Kumar Antil, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondent No.2 and has filed his Memorandum of Appearance in Court, which is taken on record.

Advance copy of the petition has been served upon the State.

Upon instructions from L/ASI Sonia, State counsel submits that the prosecutrix, who is a lady police official has supported the allegations levelled by her in her statement under Section 164 of Cr.P.C. Upon further instructions, she submits that investigation has been completed, *challan* has been presented and even charge has been framed against the petitioner.

Considering the serious nature of allegations levelled by a police official against her colleague as well as judgment of the Supreme Court in State of Madhya Pradesh versus Laxmi Narayan and others (2019) 5 SCC 688, prayer made in the petition cannot be entertained.

Petition is dismissed.
