1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/5 dated 05.04.2022, in CWP-6754-2022.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P5 dated 05.04.2022, reveals that CWP-6754-2022, was disposed of by directing the respondent that in the event of the petitioner preferring a representation within two days from the date of order, the same be considered and decided by passing a speaking order, in accordance with law, within 10 days thereafter.

3. Notice has not yet been issued in the instant case.

4. However, learned DAG, Haryana, has produced speaking order dated 29.04.2022, rejecting the claim of the petitioner as contained in the representation filed by the petitioner. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof states that in the circumstances, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to

withdraw the same with liberty to challenge order dated 29.04.2022, by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

5. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
