Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that in the present case, certain deductions were done from the pensionary benefits of the petitioner and that too without passing any order of recovery by the respondents. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that a sum of Rs.35,000/- has been recovered from the pensionary benefits of the petitioner by the respondents, which is impermissible keeping in view the settled principle of law.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the same grievance has also been raised by the petitioner before respondents No.2 to 5 by serving legal notice dated 01/03, February, 2022 (Annexure P-5), which is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage, in case a time bound direction is given to respondent No.3 to decide the said legal notice dated 01/03, February, 2022, by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of this case and

without going into merits of the claim as raised by the petitioner in the present case as well as in the legal notice dated 01/03, February, 2022 (Annexure P-5), this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to pass an appropriate speaking order on the legal notice dated 01/03, February, 2022 (Annexure P-5), filed by the petitioner, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of the copy of this order.
