This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for grant of permission to the petitioner to go to Canada to attend convocation ceremony of his son which is stated to be scheduled to be held in October 2018, during the pendency of the trial in FIR no.2 dated 03.01.2015 registered under Sections 353, 186, 506, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station Zira, District Ferozepur.

Learned State counsel has pointed out that in the present case, the petitioner has been acquitted vide judgment dated 26.07.2022 and thus, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

None has appeared on behalf of the petitioner to rebut the said fact.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous. Liberty is however, granted to the petitioner to file a fresh petition in case any cause survives.
