1. The petitioner, who is an accused in FIR No.289 of 01.11.2010, registered at Police Station City Khanna, has challenged the orders, respectively embodied in Annexures P-5, and, P-6.

2. However, today the hitherto learned counsel for the petitioner has placed on record, the death certificate of the present petitioner. Since a perusal of the death certificate reveals that, his demise has occurred during the pendency of the instant petition before this Court, thereupon the instant petition is dismissed, as becoming abated.

3. Nonetheless, the learned APP concerned, may also make an alike intimation to the learned trial Magistrate concerned, for the latter being enabled to pass an order qua the proceedings drawn against the deceased-petitioner, in respect of the petition FIR, being declared to become abated.
