Through the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in FIR No.71 dated 14.02.2019 registered under Sections 323, 376, 377, 406, 498A, 506 and 511 IPC at Police Station SGM Nagar, District Faridabad.

The FIR in question in which the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail arises from a matrimonial dispute between the petitioner and the complainant.

At the outset, learned counsel for the complainant submits that all matrimonial disputes between the petitioner and the complainant have amicably been resolved.

Learned State counsel also submits that after investigation the State has prepared a report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. seeking cancellation of the FIR in question which shall be filed before the competent Court as soon as the same is approved by the concerned Superintendent of Police.

In the light of the afore developments, this Court is of the opinion that custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not necessary and therefore order of this Court dated 25.11.2021 granting ad interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is ordered to be made absolute.
