Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.95 dated 24.03.2018 under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Sector-36, Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was granted regular bail by this Court vide order dated 16.10.2018 passed in CRM-M-18318-2018 and thereafter, he was regularly appearing before the trial Court, however, he absented from the Court proceedings on 21.10.2021 on account of the fact that his daughter died due to dengue. In the meantime, his bail/surety bonds were cancelled and non-bailable warrants were issued against him. It is further submitted that the petitioner is ready to surrender before the trial Court

and apply for fresh bail.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Simsi Dhir Malhotra, APP, U.T. Chandigarh accepts notice on behalf of the respondent and has not disputed the factual position.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties and considering the aforesaid submission, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to surrender before the trial Court within a period of 10 days from today and he will be released on bail subject to his furnishing fresh bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court, however, subject to deposit of costs of Rs.10,000/- with the State Legal Services Authority, Chandigarh.
