The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of appropriate directions to respondents no.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and her family members from respondents no.4 and 5.

Notice in the petition was issued and the State was directed to file a status report in the matter. The same has been filed.

Learned State counsel submits that allegations levelled by the petitioner have been duly assessed and the same are not substantiated in view of the investigation conducted so far. She has drawn attention of this Court to the status report filed wherein it has been disclosed that there were two FIRs registered on behest of the petitioner i.e. FIR No.220 dated 13.11.2018 and FIR No.92 dated 7.4.2021. The investigating agency had constituted a S.I.T for conducting a thorough investigation and the same were carried out accordingly. It is submitted that respondent no.4 was acquitted by the Trial Court in FIR No.220 dated 13.11.2018 as the petitioner had turned hostile. So far as FIR No.92 dated 7.4.2021 is concerned, the SIT submitted its report with the findings that no offence

under Section 341 IPC was found to be committed and hence the same was recommended to be deleted. Further it was examined by the D.A. (Legal), SAS Nagar and opined that no further action is required to be taken.

In view of the submissions made by learned State counsel, it is evident that the allegations have been duly investigated. The matter would be evaluated by the Trial Court on conclusion of the investigation.

In view of the facts and circumstances, present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to approach the appropriate authority in case of any fresh grievance.
