[1] Prayer in the petition is for taking action against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 10.01.2019 in CWP No.28594 of 2017.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 dated 10.01.2019 reveals that CWP No.28594 of 2017 was allowed by directing the respondents to initiate proceedings for acquisition of the land in accordance with law within three months from the receipt of certified copy of the order and finalize the same within further period of three months thereafter.

[3] Learned Addl. A.G. contends that in pursuance of order, Annexure P/1 acquisition proceedings have been completed and award dated 22.11.2021 has been passed by the Land Acquisition Collector, Haryana PWD (B&R), Ambala Cantt, therefore, order, Annexure P/1 having been complied with, no action under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 is called for against the respondents.

[4] Learned counsel for the petitioner on instructions from the petitioner states that in view of order, Annexure P/1 dated 10.01.2019 in

CWP No. 28594 of 2017 having been complied with, land of the petitioners having been acquired and award in respect thereto having been passed on 22.11.2021 by the Land Acquisition Collector, Haryana PWD (B&R), Ambala Cant, the petitioner does not press the instant petition.

[5] In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
