**ANIL KSHETARPAL, J (Oral)**

The petitioners herein are the defendants in a pending suit. The trial court has allowed the plaintiffs to amend the plaint, in order to seek relief of damages, on account of business loss, excessive rice having been taken away and the freight charges. The plaintiffs are rice millers whereas the defendants are the Government agencies which are in the business of procurement of paddy on behalf of the Government.

It has been brought to the notice of the Court that after the amended plaint was filed, the defendants have already filed their written statement and on completion of the pleadings, the court has not only framed the issues, even the plaintiffs have already led some part of their evidence, i.e the trial has reached the stage of plaintiff's evidence.

It is admitted by the learned counsel representing the petitioners that the trial court has already framed issue no.9 with regard to limitation.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, at this stage no ground to interfere is made out.

Hence, dismissed.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
