The instant petition had been filed under Section 482 CrPC for issuance of directions to the respondents not to harass and humiliate the petitioners and also seeking protection of life and liberty against being falsely implicated in a case under the NDPS Act or in other case.

Reply by way of affidavit has been filed by Assistant Commissioner of Police (Investigation), Jalandhar. The relevant extract of the said para is reproduced as hereinbelow:-

2. That on 08/08/2017 ASI Ajinder Singh along with other police officials were present at Nakoder Chowk, Jalandhar where he received secret information that Surjit Lal @ Sodhi was selling heroine. He has been convicted in many cases and was now confined in central jail kapurthala. He had come on parole few days back and then again went in jail. During his parole he had obtained huge quantity of heroine. His brother-in-law (Sala) Parmjit Singh @ Rohit who was presently living in the house of Surjit Lal @ Sodhi at Ludhiana and was selling heroine through the sources of Surjit Lal @ Sodhi. The ASI

intercepted innova vehicle and arrested Parmjit Singh @ Rohit and Mohit Kumar @ Mintu and recovered 150 Grams of Heroine from the possession of Parmjit Singh and from Mohit Kumar @ Mintu 100 Grams of Heroine Which Was taken in to Possession as per rules. Surjit Lal @ Sodhi who was detained in Central Jail Kapurthala was brought through production warrants and was produced in court on 11/08/2017 and arrested in this case. A list of cases registered against Surjit Lal @ Sodhi is attached as Annexure R-1.

3. That both the petitioners are wife and mother of petitioner respectively of Surjit Lal Sodhi accused. The petitioner have filed the present petition without any valid and reasonable cause. They have never been harassed nor humiliated. Their threat perception is totally false and baseless. They are neither required nor ever called called by the answering respondent. In view of the above submissions the above mentioned petition filed by the petitioner deserved to be dismissed.

It is evident from the perusal of the same that husband of the petitioner No.1 was involved in the sale of heroin. It is further pointed out that no threat, harassmt or humiliation is being extended to the petitioners and that they never been called to the Police Station or required for any case.

In view of the extract of the affidavit reproduced above. No further orders are called for.

Instant petition is dismissed as not pressed.
