Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the question whether an employee is entitled for grant of increment in respect of the adhoc services, is pending consideration with the respondents and hence, respondents be directed to decide the claim of the petitioner being raised by way of representation dated 08.12.2021 (Anenxure P/8) along with the similarly situated employees as to whether the benefit of adhoc service is to be given for the purpose of grant of increment or not.

Learned State counsel submits that in case representation filed by the petitioner has not been decided by the respondents so far, the same will be decided in accordance with law and an appropriate order will be passed within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement made by learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly

be disposed off having been not pressed any further.
